## Things to do to cast your vote Executive Committee and Senate Elections

- Members are to receive a ballot paper and an election envelope from your school representative(s) (members from tertiary institutes and school principal members will receive the ballot paper by post individually).
- With the ballot paper and the election envelope in hand, do the following:
  - Fill the ballot paper according to instructions.
  - Put the ballot paper into the election envelope.
  - Sign your name on the back of the election envelope in the space specified.
  - Seal the election envelope.
- Return your ballot paper within the election envelope either
  - By post, either having it entrusted with your school representative(s) (who will have it mailed together with the ballot papers of other colleagues collectively), or having it mailed individually by yourself, or
  - By hand and have it cast into the **Ballot Box** placed in PTU Mong Kok or Causeway Bay Service Centre.

## The Senate Election 19 Senate Members are to be Elected

In accordance with the Constitution of our Union, the Senate Election is to take place in the form of "Individual candidacy" and nineteen members are to be elected to form the Senate. When the deadline for submission of nomination for the Senate was over, the Election Sub-Committee had received submission from 19 candidates.

The total number of candidates is not more than 19, therefore this is a Confidence or No Confidence vote. The Senate will be formed by whoever obtains vote of confidence exceeding vote of non-confidence in number shall be a Senate member for the next term. The formation has to satisfy the condition that not more than one-third (i.e. 6 people) shall be headmasters or employees of the Education Bureau or other non-school organisations, and not more than one-half (i.e. 9 people) shall be honorary members, and the sum of the above two groups shall not exceed two-third (i.e. 12 people) of the total membership. The elected numbers are to elect the Chairman, Vice-chairman, and Secretary of the Senate among themselves.

### Who has the Right to vote

In accordance with the Constitution of our Union, all members\* are entitled to vote automatically in both the Executive Committee Election and Senate Election.

\*In accordance with the resolution of the Election Sub-Committee, members are defined according to the members' registration record of the Union by 30th December, 2019.

*In accordance with the Trade Union Ordinance, members who are in retirement are not entitled to vote, and consequently honorary members are not entitled to vote in the Executive Committee and Senate Election.*

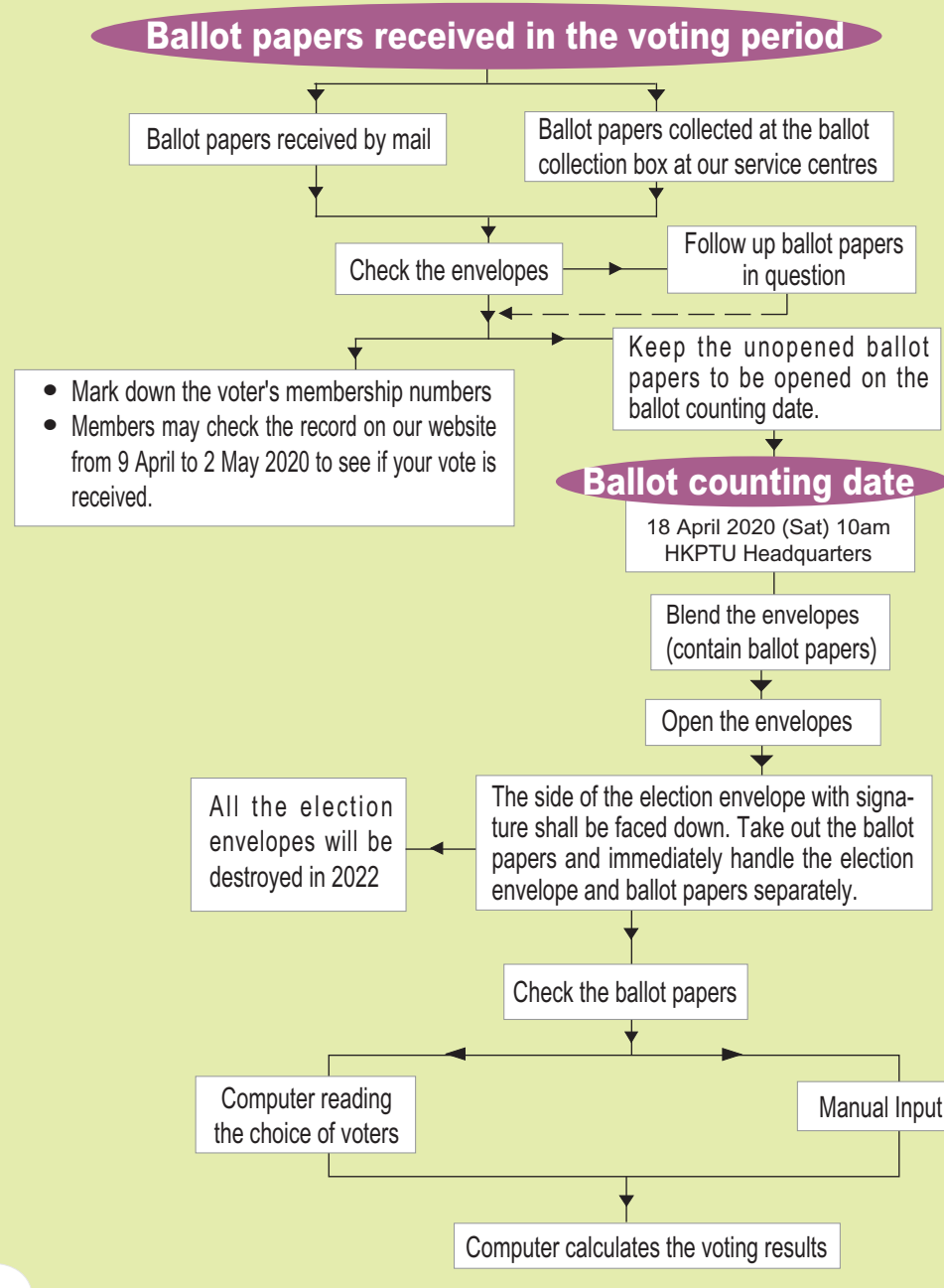
## The Executive Committee Election Vote of Confidence

In accordance with the Constitution of our Union, the Executive Committee Election is to be carried out in the form of voting for Proposed Executive Committee(s). When the deadline for submission of Proposed Executive Committee was over, the Election Sub-Committee had received submission only from the **Proposed Fung Wai Wah Committee (Vice-president: Chong Yiu Kwong, Ip Kin Yuen, Tin Fong Chak, Wong Mo Yee)**.

In accordance with the Constitution of our Union, when there is only one Proposed Executive Committee, a **vote of confidence** has to be cast by all (excepting honorary) members in the form of **one-person-one-vote secret ballot**. If the number of "Confidence" votes exceeds that of "No Confidence", the Proposed Executive Committee will be elected the Executive Committee for the next term of office.

<sup>△</sup> Special voting arrangement for the replacement ballot or the resent ballot due to the member's out-of-office status: A member who gets such replacement or resent ballot issued by the Election Committee on or after 19 March may deliver his/her vote to the Union by hand or by post (based on postmark date) on or before 7 April 2020, and such ballot would still be regarded as valid.
